Dear Families,

Summer Camp at All Saints Day School allows the children to explore different topics and leaves them rejuvenated to return to the more diligent nature of structured activities during the school year. In less than four months, the end of the school year will be upon us and it will be time for our summer adventures. Our themed summer program will keep your child learning with a fun filled program. They are allowed the freedom to invent their own projects, they are physically challenged, and they have a chance to learn new skills. The schedule is flexible and offers enough security, independence and stimulation to meet the needs of the child.

Our 2020 weekly themes will include:

- STEAM and Robotics
- Karate
- Science
- Artist's Clay and Painting
- Chef and Kitchen Culinary Arts
- Sports Camps
- Imagination Station and Trips for Older Bunk

1. For safety and security reasons, please know that we have limited the number of major outings as we prefer to keep the children within the All Saints building, playground, or in facilities which house smaller capacities.
2. We will utilize our beautiful and safe playground for all of our onsite entertainment, sand and water play, and picnics. As always with our open door policy, we welcome parents/guardians to participate in our activities, visit our shows, and serve as chaperones.
3. As this is the traditional time for movement in our industry we have many new families looking for full-time childcare arrangements for the summer. Our waiting list is growing every day; now is the time to secure your spot.
4. Families who are currently enrolled at All Saints have priority on Summer Camp Enrollment.

**Rules and Guidelines**

1. Because the majority of our activities will begin early, we ask that all children be in attendance no later than 9:00 a.m. starting on June 8th to August 21<sup>st</sup>. Remember if the children arrive after 9:00 a.m. they will be missing many of the activities.
2. Our program ages is from 3 – 11 years old.
3. Remember Before and Aftercare are available.
4. Please, dress your child comfortably so that he or she may take advantage of all learning opportunities, indoors and outdoors. Your child should wear clothing that is washable and adaptable to food spills, paint and water play. Girls should wear shorts under dresses.
5. No flip-flops or crocs will be allowed.
6. Please provide a labeled Ziploc bag with a full change of summer clothing, including socks and water shoes to be left in your child's cubbies and please remove current winter clothing.
7. All children are required to have their own labeled sunblock Spray only.
8. You may pick and choose weeks you would like to attend.

**Tuition and Fees**

1. Summer Camp Registration/Enrichment Fee which will cover all admissions, in house presentations and programs is: \$60.00 per child in addition to the weekly tuition.
2. Summer Camp Registration/Enrichment Fees will be due on the following dates: By May 4<sup>th</sup>. Weekly payments need to be paid Monday of each week.

Note: Activities are subject to change due to weather conditions or availability.

7. If your child has an IEP, the most recent copy must be shared with the school at the time of registration.
